### **Plant a tree with NEBP**

North East Business Park's (NEBP) public tree planting ceremony will take place this weekend with more than 1,000 trees to be planted in the first stage of a revegetation program.

Starting at 8am on Sunday, the planting ceremony will celebrate the transformation and revegetation of 4.3 hectares of degraded land along a 400 metre stretch of the Caboolture River.

North East Business Park (NEBP) Chief Executive Officer Jeff Smith said the community tree planting day was gaining momentum and he expected a strong turn-out on Sunday.

"The event will launch the substantial revegetation of a large area set aside as public open space at Northeast Business Park and has attracted support from local businesses and clubs," Mr Smith said.

"The planting session is a chance for each member of the public to plant one of the first 1000 trees as part of the revegetation program and over the following weeks Greening Australia will plant another 5,500trees."

Mr Smith said Kangaroo Bus Lines will transport the participants from the entry point at the NEBP access road (Nolan Drive) to the planting site and Queensland Hire will assist with the site set up and facilities on the day.

Mr Smith said food and drink will be supplied by Caboolture River Fishing and Boating Club and local community radio station 101.5FM will be providing entertainment.

"We have had some great community support for this project which demonstrates not only significant support for our revegetation program but also for the overall development plans for the local area," Mr Smith said.
