BUYING AT NORTH HARBOUR

2022 continues to be an incredibly busy year for all at North Harbour. Our enquiry numbers remain at unprecedented levels, with demand for land in our beautiful community consistently high. Sales of established homes at North Harbour are also moving swiftly with record prices being attained, once more showing the value of purchasing in our growing community. Not only for buyers looking for their first ever home, this is also well worth a read if you are buying land to build for the first time. We've also spoken to two of our most valued specialists, Renee Black from Mortgage Achievers and Carol Draper from CJC Law, to get their expert advice on the buying process from a financial and legal perspective.



Renee Black from Mortgage Achievers specialises in construction, land and new build mortgages and her expert knowledge has helped many of our buyers achieve their dreams. We spoke to her about what buyers should consider, before beginning their home buying journey.

What is the first thing you suggest people do before starting to save for a home?

Definitely speak to a Mortgage Advisor. There are numerous considerations to determine when you will be able to purchase, which are constantly changing. We can review your current situation and put a plan in place around savings, employment etc to meet your goals. This could range from being ready to purchase now or creating a savings plan to purchase in the near future.

How much deposit do you need to buy a home?

The minimum deposit required can vary based on a number of factors such as; type of property being purchased and location, construction loan, source of your deposit, Investment property versus owner occupied property to name a few.

As a guide you would need a minimum deposit of 5% of the purchase price + purchase costs 2.5 - 3%, totalling up to 8% for an Owner Occupied property.

Investors currently need a 10% deposit + purchase costs, approximately 13% overall of the purchase price.

What is important to look for in a mortgage broker?

A recommendation is always a good place to start. You want an Advisor who listens and spends time reviewing your situation so they can find the best possible outcome for you. A good Advisor explains your lender options to you and why they are the best option for you. They will have the knowledge to assist you in making that final lender choice.

You want someone who delivers on their promises and provides you with regular updates during the process.

What is the best advice you can give someone looking to buy a block of land?

Securing land is the first step in your journey to build a new home. A pre-approval is extremely important to secure land in today's market as you may need to act quickly.

It is important to speak with an Advisor such as myself who has extensive knowledge in land and construction loans as they are very different to purchasing an established house. We assist you throughout the entire journey until you get the keys, move in and beyond.

Carol Draper from CJC Law and her team have assisted a number of North Harbour buyers. Not only are they experts, they are also great to work with! Carol has put together a quick guide to conveyancing, below.

"When a buyer or seller signs a contract of sale it is likely to be one of the biggest financial transactions of their life. With the stroke of the pen comes an enormous number of legalities; so, when you are buying land or property, you need an experienced conveyancing lawyer to guide you through this process.

Conveyancing in Queensland is complex and is affected by at least 20 different pieces of State and Federal legislation, contract conditions, extensive case law and practice guidelines. Your lawyer will need to ensure the critical dates of your contract (finance, building and pest conditions, settlement etc.) are confirmed by 5pm on the due date, failing which the other party can terminate the contract. Your lawyer will liaise with your bank to book settlement and then provide you with settlement figures and explain why and when funds are to be payable. If you have any questions, you should direct them to your lawyer for professional advice.

When you are looking for a conveyancer, go for experience and not just price. I recommend choosing a local lawyer who knows the area, is approachable and has the local connections and knowledge of the area and surroundings. You also want a lawyer who will sit down with



you as needed and witness your mortgage documents, or answer any queries you may have from time to time. Purchasing a property is a major step in your life so do not just go for the cheapest option as it may cost you in the long term."
